THE ULTIMATE LEMON CAKE

PREP/COOKING TIME
1 Hour

INGREDIENTS

Italian Lemon Olive Oil Cake:

- 1 CUP EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL OR CANOLA OIL
- 3 EGGS
- 1 1/2 CUP WHOLE MILK
- 1 TABLESPOON FRESH LEMON JUICE
- 2 TABLESPOONS FRESH LEMON PEEL
- 1 CUP SUGAR
- 2 CUPS FLOUR
- 1 TEASPOON BAKING POWDER
- 1/2 TEASPOON BAKING SODA
- 1 TEASPOON SALT

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 325 degrees.

In a large mixing bowl, add oil, eggs, whole milk, lemon juice, and lemon zest. Cream for 2 minutes. In large bowl, add sugar, flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Stir into egg mixture and fold. Spray two 9-inch or three 8-inch cake pans with nonstick cooking spray. Place batter into baking pans. If using three 8-inch pans, bake for 20-25 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. If using two 9-inch pans, bake for 30-35 minutes. Cool.

To make frosting:

In a large bowl, cream together butter and cream cheese for 4-5 minutes until light and fluffy, scraping sides of bowl often. Add powdered sugar, lemon juice, vanilla and lemon zest and cream together. Chill.

To assemble cake:

Remove cakes from pan. Spread frosting on top of one cooled cake layer. Place other cooled cake layer






